## Impact of Sport Premium funding (Sept 2013 — July 2018)



### COMPETITION

- Level 1 up 63% from average 540 pre-Sport Premium to 882 in 2017-18
- Level 2/3 up 71% from average 198 pre-Sport Premium to 338 in 2017-18
- 100% of children participated in Level 1 competition and 69% in Level 2/3 in 2017-18
- Level 3 participation in 4 of the last 5 years (Basketball, Hockey, Boccia, Athletics)
- Total participation up 65% from average 741 pre-Sport Premium to 1220 in 2017-18

### CLUBS & OPPORTUNITIES

- Club hours up 132% from average 1692 pre-Sport Premium to 4208 in 2017-18
- KS1 hours: up from average 340 pre-Sport Premium to 1602 in 2017-18
- KS2 hours: up from average 1352 pre-Sport Premium to 2606 in 2017-18
- Average KS1 participants up from 19.37% pre-Sport Premium to 73.61% in 2017-18
- Average KS2 participants up from 72.23% pre-Sport Premium to 77.09% in 2017-18
- Average Total participants up from 48.79% pre-Sport Premium to 75.60% in 2017-18
