Notice for Parents of Children in Year 3 from September 2016 Free School Meals

Automatic entitlement to a free school meal finishes at the end of Year 2 and only children from **low income families** are eligible from Year 3.

If your household income is less than £16,190 per year, or you receive Income Support or an equivalent benefit, you will need to make an application in August if you want your child to receive a free school meal from September.

Carter D – for brilliant effort and commitment in EVERY lesson this year.

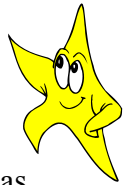
Seytian T – for great progress in writing and a much improved attitude.
