- 4<sup>th</sup> – Kingfishers.

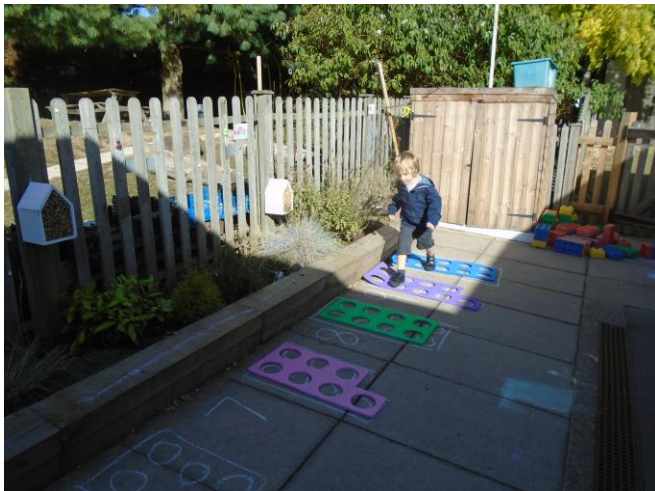


### Be a Reader" Class award

Mikey S – for trying hard in Maths this week.

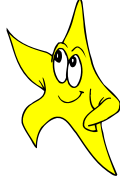
Christopher T – for a brilliant portrait of Samuel Pepys and fantastic effort with his writing.
