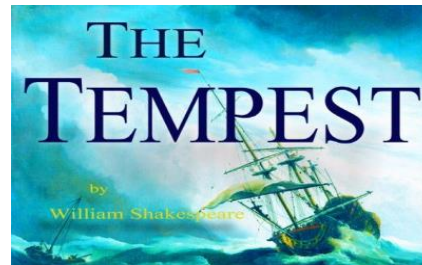
Year3 Lion King Dance
