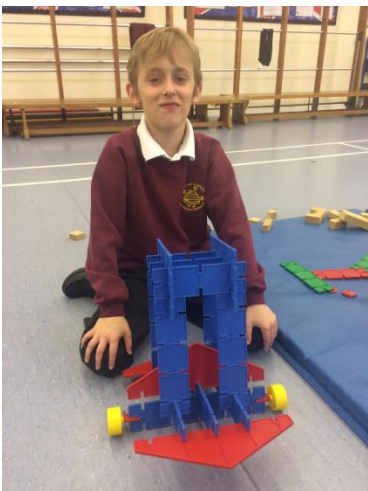
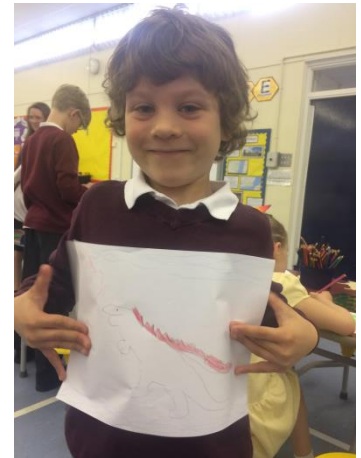
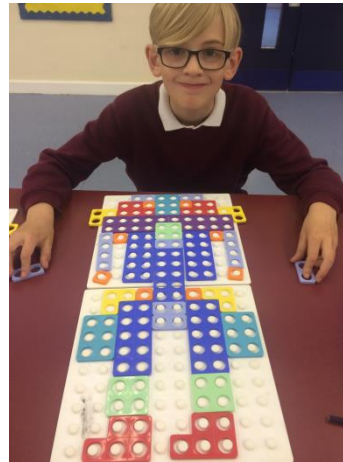

Looking forward to next week, Year 1 have been practising for their class assembly which will be showcased on Thursday morning.

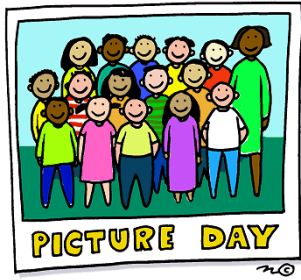
