Thank you for all donations of resources. We still have some blankets/tarpaulins in the hall if you need them back.

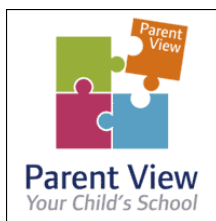
We raised an amazing £238.60 which will be donated to Save the Children to continue their work across the world, supplying shelters, food and money for families in need.

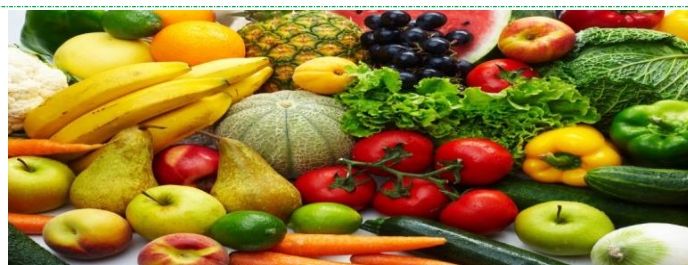

As summer is now here, it is important that children are properly protected from the sun with cream applied before they come into school, a water bottle and a sun hat



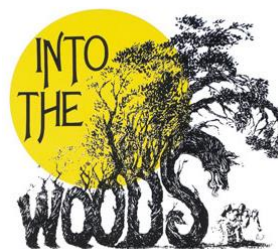
