### Dear Parent,

The new secondary school admission round opened on Tuesday 12 September 2017, for current Year 6 children to apply for a secondary school (Year 7) place for September 2018.

The statutory national closing date for applications is 31st October 2017.

Applications can be made online via [www.essex.gov.uk/admissions](http://www.essex.gov.uk/admissions). 98% of parents in Essex applied online last year.

The website also has a copy of the Secondary Education in Essex 2018-19 booklet which contains details of all secondary school admission policies. know that parents will often contact schools with enquiries and I hope this note is helpful in referring you the information available on the website.

Finally, although the primary (Reception) admission round for September 2018 does not open until 13 November 2017 (that is the date from which applications can be made for Reception 2018-19), the relevant booklets have been published and are on the webpage below:
