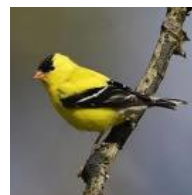
### Streetdance

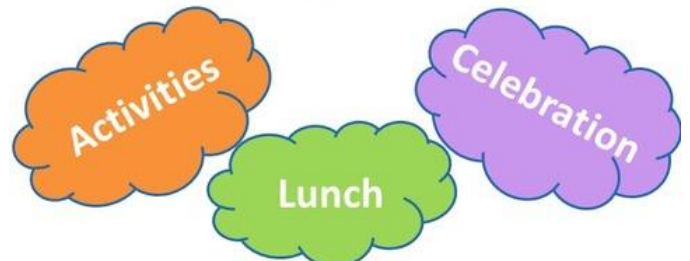
