Welcome back to the Beehive Express! We have had a great week and time has shot past at a great rate of knots.

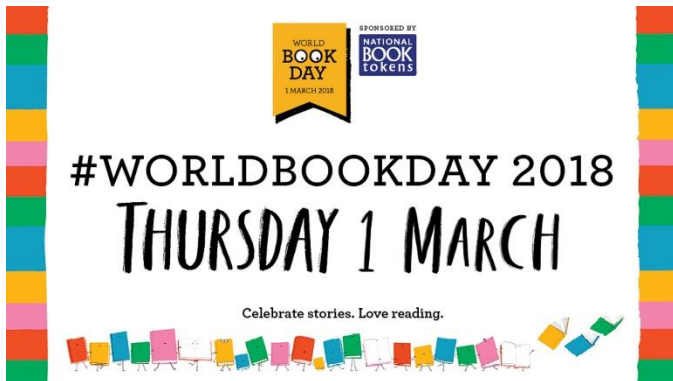
