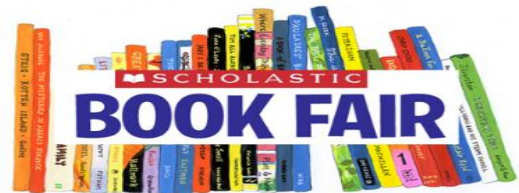
Everyone at Beehive Lane would like to Welcome **Ho Ching** and **Ismet** and wish them a wonderful learning experience with us.
