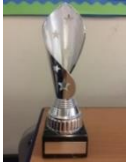
My Clothing

**Olivia H** for excellent understanding and use of methods to solve very complicated comparative bar model problems in Maths.

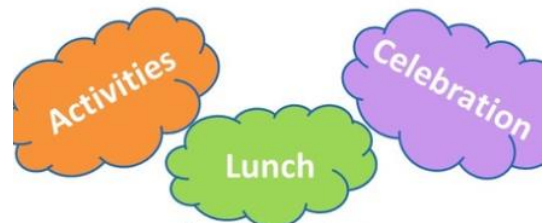
